

Venue – Urania Berlin


Directions: Coming from Berlin Central station, you can take the S-Bahn from platform 15/16 with any of the S-Bahn lines in the direction of *Zoologischer Garten* (S3 to *Spandau*, S5 to *Westkreuz*, or S7 to *Potsdam Hbf*). Exit the train at *Zoologischer Garten*, the third stop, and switch to the U12 Direction *Warschauer Straße*. Get off at the first stop *Wittenbergplatz*, from where it is only a five-minute walk down the *Kleiststraße* before turning left to *An der Urania*, where you can find the venue on the right-hand side of the two-lane road.

The venue is also in close proximity to U-Bahn *Nollendorfplatz* (eight-minute walk, see page 4). Both U *Wittenbergplatz* and U *Nollendorfplatz* can also be reached by the U3 and U12 lines.



Tickets: Tickets for public transportation in Berlin can be bought at any station at the ticket vending machine or via the BVG App (available both for [iPhone](#) and on [Google Playstore](#)). **Within the Berlin city centre you will need a ticket for the AB area. Participants travelling from and to the BER airport will need a ticket for the ABC area.**

Hotel: Motel One at Spittelmarkt



If IEP has reserved a room for you, you will be staying at [Motel One, Spittelmarkt](#). The address is: **Leipziger Str. 50, 10117 Berlin.**

Please note, that the rooms are available starting from 15:00h.

If you arrive at the Hotel in Berlin before, ask the reception at Motel One if rooms are already available - in this case you may of course check in. Otherwise, you can deposit your luggage at the Hotel.


Directions coming from Berlin Central Station: the hotel can be reached by taking the underground line U5 (Direction *Tierpark* or Direction *Hönow*). You can exit the underground at



station *Museumsinsel* and walk 15 minutes South along the Spreekanal from there. Alternatively, you can continue in the U5 until *Alexanderplatz*, switch to the U2 (Direction *Gleisdreieck*) from there, and exit at U *Spittelmarkt*, which is just 150 meters from the hotel.

Directions from Berlin-Brandenburg Airport (BER): Take the Regional Train RE7 (direction *Dessau Hbf. / Bad Belzig Bhf.*) or RB14 (direction *Nauen*) to *Alexanderplatz* (duration approx. 25 minutes). Change into the U-Bahn line U2 (Direction *Gleisdreieck*) and exit at U *Spittelmarkt*.

Directions from the Hotel to the Conference Venue



Directions: Take the U2 (Direction *Gleisdreieck*) from *Spittelmarkt* to *Gleisdreieck* (six stops, ten minutes). Here, you need to switch to the U12 line (Direction *Ruhleben*) or the U3 (Direction *Krumme Lanke*) and exit at *Nollendorfplatz* after two stops (3 minutes). From there, it is an eight-minute walk to *Urania* up the *Kleiststraße*, before turning right and finding the conference location at your right side after 100 meters.

Alternatively, you can stay in the U12 for one more station until *Wittenbergplatz*, and follow the walking route outlined on page 2 (five-minute walk).

Please note: These directions take into account the effects of the reconstruction work on the U2 line that will begin on 26 August 2022.



Point of Information: COVID-19 Regulations in force in Berlin

We are very much looking forward to hold the IEP Annual Conference in person again. Still, the COVID-19 pandemic is ongoing, and there continue to be measures in place in Berlin to contain the spread of the virus.

An overview of current measures can be found [here](#). At present, the most relevant information is it is mandatory to wear an FFP2 mask when using public transportation.

There are currently no prescriptions in terms of testing or limited capacity for events. Should restrictions be again put into place at the time of the event, the location could provide sufficient space to ensure 1,5 meters' distance between participants.

While it is not mandatory to do a test prior to the event, we do encourage you to take a rapid self-test before joining. IEP will provide a limited number of self-tests at the conference venue. There is also a high number of testing centers in Berlin, which offer a rapid test at a cost of 3 €. There is no test center in direct vicinity to the hotel, the closest one being [Teststation Annenstraße, Annenstraße 13, 10179 Berlin](#).
